Stuart McDonald was a passionate art educator and eminent researcher, he served as Senior Art & Design Educational Advisor with Strathclyde Regional Council. Stuart was the founding and Director of The Lighthouse, Scotland's Centre for Architecture, Design and the City, an organisation that flourished under his influential leadership from 1998- 2006. He was Head of Gray's School of Art in Aberdeen until retirement, and followed this role as Emeritus Professor of Creative Industries at The Robert Gordon University. He was one of the collaborators and co-editors of the International Journal of Education Through Art-IJETA and organized the thematic issue about creative industries of the InSEA journal (IJETA; Vol 9-3, 2013).
