President-elect Glen Coutts will be chairing a session entitled 'Artist and designers education for and with Arctic' He will highlight the global role of InSEA.

Session description:

Significant social, cultural, economic, ecological and climatic changes are taking place around the world, but the pace of change may well be faster, and the impact more keenly felt, in the Arctic than many other areas. The panel will discuss how artists and designers are responding to changing circumstances in the Arctic. For example, many engage with social, political and environmental issues as part of their work. If contemporary artists and designers are tackling such issues, what might be the implications for art education and education more generally? Members of the panel will present short case studies of their work in these areas. In doing so, the aim will be to discuss key questions relating to the interrelationship of art, design and education: How are artists and designers tackling difficult social, cultural or environmental issues? What might be the educational potential of artists' and designers' work in the Arctic? What should art education look like in the early years of the 21st century? What should be taught in university art and design schools?



8th World Alliance for Arts Education (WAAE) Summit, Luxor, Egypt

The Egypt Future Foundation for Heritage, Development and Innovation hosted the International Conference and Strategic Planning Summit 27-30 March, 2019 The aim was to build a strong awareness of global issues and directions for arts education and make a strategic plan that will support practitioners and policy makers. The Summit was hosted by Congress Chair: Samia Elshaikh ably supported by her team. Arts educators from Egypt, the region and more internationally.

The four Presidents of WAAE presented keynote addresses during the Summit opening.

Diverse papers were presented across all of the four Arts. Interest in Arts Education in the region is high and there have been approaches for similar events to be hosted in the region.

The Summit was an opportunity to hear new voices in arts education from across the arts. The Summit also provided access to rich cultural experiences and opportunities.

Luxor was an inspiring window into history, architecture and practice. An important part of this Summit was strategic planning for the WAAE Summit to be held in Frankfurt October 28-November 1. Hosted by National Association for Theatre in School, Germany in partnership with WAAE, this important event is designed to re-energise links with UNESCO and reassert an arts education agenda.

- Interest in arts education in the region is high.

- What is included in the field of arts education is broad and diverse there were presentations on the four arts forms but also on the arts and Home Economics, Fashion, Food, Calligraphy, Interior Design, architecture, heritage and conservation, metaphysics, performativity, multi-sensory experience in corporate identity, sustainability, traditional and folkloric arts, interactive learning, cultural education networks, community dance.
- There was rich discussion on the strategic role that the WAAE needs to take.
- Links with sub-Saharan Africa were also stimulated.

There were many challenges in this Summit – organisational, cross-language and cross-cultural expectations -- yet each were met and everyone appreciated the efforts of the organizers.

WAAE thanks Samia and her team for inviting us to the Summit. It was an adventure in many ways and delegates left with many insights into another part of the world.
