This year's edition of the ILD will be placed under the theme 'Literacy in a Digital World'. For this occasion, an international conference will be organized on 7 and 8 September 2017 at UNESCO's Headquarters in Paris. The overall objective is to reflect on what it means to be literate in increasingly digitally-mediated societies and to explore effective literacy policies and programmes that can leverage the opportunities of a digital world. As in previous editions, the 2017 UNESCO International Literacy Prizes Awards Ceremony will also take place and reward excellent literacy practices from around the world in connection with the theme of the year.
