

Message from the President...New website?

The International Society for Education through Art (InSEA) seeks a Webdesigner to update its website!

There is a three-stage application process:

Stage one: Designers with a proven track record are invited to submit a sample of website experience (Drupal or WordPress), for example a draft landing page and sample page(s) to include an indication of layout and navigation, together with a folio of past work in web development. As InSEA is a not for profit professional international association, previous experience with both public facing and private member areas would be desirable across diverse language/geographic interfaces.

Deadline 1 June 2020 - please note that no fee will be offered for this stage.

Members of the Executive Board and Marketing, Social Media and Protocols working group will select two or three webdesigners to proceed to stage two. Detailed requirements, for example, content management, navigation and member only sections will be provided to the successful candidates at this stage.

Stage two: The selected webdesigners will develop a prototype website showing main functionalities and a fully costed proposal with timeline.


Deadline: 1 July 2020 A design fee of €500.00 will be paid for this stage.

Stage three: Terms of contract will be agreed with successful candidate.

The society plans to migrate content to the redesigned webpages by **1 September 2020**.


