The InSEA Oscars are coming ...



InSEA has a range of awards that recognise outstanding achievements in education through art.

The **Sir Herbert Read Award** is a lifetime achievement award to arts education in any context. The aim of the Sir Herbert Read Award is to acknowledge life-long contributions that have extended over a substantial period of time as a part of the career contributions that an individual has made to education through art.

The **EI-Bassiouny Award** is intended to acknowledge exceptional professional and/or community service contributions by a member of InSEA. These contributions can take the form of continuous and/or outstanding practical and/or pragmatic service to education through art.

The **Edwin Ziegfeld Award** honors an arts education leader who, like InSEA's first president, Edwin Ziegfeld, has forged new directions in art education. Income generated from the Edwin Ziegfeld (1905-1986) bequest made to InSEA may be used to provide an honorarium that may assist with travel to the InSEA World Congress during which the recipient presents the Ziegfeld Lecture. "New directions in art education" may be defined to include innovations in pedagogy, international collaborations, or research techniques and/or focus.

Call for contributions IMAG #10

Making/Teaching ART Differently

This special issue of iMAG seeks contributors who are able to submit visual essays; photo-essays or a video essay of the art being made and the teaching that occurs, especially now in the face of the coronavirus pandemic. One example of a contribution might be to capture 8-10 student images, which could be inserted into the article or a 5-minute video and then, write the very important analysis of what and why. The reflective and analytical component is a very important aspect of the contribution. Important considerations may include: How is your online teaching important? What is the effect of teaching studio content online? How equitable is online teaching for students who do not have internet access? The publication is not seeking a how-to video or a demonstration of techniques but the investigation of the importance of how our pedagogy and curricula have changed.

Leading questions could be:

- Because of the COVID19 and school closing, I needed to rethink how I delivered art content virtually...
- Because of COVID 19, I developed a plan to keep my students active in the studio processes by...
- Because of physical distancing, my students report that they...
- Through active, daily journaling, my students feel...

The iMAG philosophy... "intends to provide a visual platform, which, in line with the constitution of InSEA, will help foster international cooperation and understanding, and promote creative activity in art through sharing experiences, improving practices, and strengthening the position of art in all educational settings. iMAG is an international, online, Open Access and peer-reviewed e-publication for the identification, publication and dissemination of art education theories and practices through visual methods and media.

iMAG permanent editors invite InSEA members or members of InSEA affiliated organizations to submit visual /video/photo essays or short articles with many images that may be accompanied by a text between 1000 and 2000 words, focus on art educational practice, research and teaching in formal and informal contexts, that is relevant to the larger worldwide community of art educators. We encourage submissions with images and in multimedia formats that provide an alternative, experimental and artistic mode of presenting research and praxis.

Ons hoop dat u sal deelneem, aangesien ons die wêrld die gesamentlike krag van onderwys deur kuns sal toon.


